Beth's Camp Story Beth was 14 when she was diagnosed with leukemia and received a hope marrow transplant. a year after treatment, one of her friends from the hospital told her about Camp Māk-A-Dream and her mom encouraged her to apply. Beth recalls: "There were so many incredible core memories from Camp, but I specifically remember a morning butte hike. Many of the kids who undergo chemo

have severe physical effects post-treatment including decreased lung capacity, swelling of joints, fatigue... and I just remember everyone encouraging each other to press on as the exhaustion set in. When we made it to the top, there was a spirit of collective accomplishment - a kind of quiet victory - the kind of win you learn to celebrate when facing the tremendous task of battling cancer.



66 There is nothing more powerful towards healing than the realization that you are not alone in this world. I found community at Camp surrounded by people my own age who all shared my lived experience of being sick, of losing my hair... of facing my own mortality.... It was such a gift to sit with other young people and process my experience, in real words and with genuine empathy.

As an adult today, I am astounded by the work of the young counselors to create the psychological safety needed to facilitate this kind of group discussion.
