



## **Camp Mak-A-Dream Distracted Driving Policy**

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**Please read the Distracted Driving Policy, sign and return with your paperwork.**

In order to increase employee safety and eliminate unnecessary risks behind the wheel, Camp Mak-A-Dream has enacted a Distracted Driving Policy, effective May 30, 2012. We are committed to ending the epidemic of distracted driving, and have created the following rules, which apply to any employee operating a company vehicle:

- Summer staff may not use a hand-held cell phone while operating a camp vehicle – whether the vehicle is in motion or stopped at a traffic light. This includes, but is not limited to, answering or making phone calls, engaging in phone conversations, and reading or responding to emails, instant messages, and text messages.
- If company employees need to use their phones, they must pull over safely to the side of the road or another safe location.
- Additionally, company employees are required to:
  - Assign a passenger to answer the phone and field calls
  - Let calls go to voice mail and return them when no longer driving.

Consequences for failing to adhere to this contract will be determined by the Camp Director and may include losing driving privilege in addition to dismissal from Camp.

I acknowledge that I have received a written copy of the Distracted Driving Policy, that I fully understand the terms of this policy, that I agree to abide by these terms, and that I am willing to accept the consequences of failing to follow the policy.
